

## Materials we'll be using:

- Worsted weight yarn (4)

2 colours of your preference
-Hooks 3.5 mm 5 mm and 6.5 mm

- Scissors
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers(optional)
Stitches you'll need to know
Chain
Slip stitch
Yarn over slip stitch
Abbreviations we'll be usingCH - chain
SS - slip stitchYO SS - yarn over slip stitch H-crochet hookBLO - back loop only
T-CH- turning chain

This cardigan we'll be making out of 6 different parts which we'll connect in the end with a slip stitch.


## Newborn Size

150 gr of yarn
We'll be making sleeves first
CH 16 H\#6.5
Row 1: 10 YO SS using H\# 6,5, 5 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH 1
Row 2: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 10 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, CH 3 turn
Row 3: 12 YO SS BLO\# 6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 4: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 12 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3, CH 3 turn

We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 9, 23 stitches total


Row 9: 18 YO SS using H\#6.5, 5 YO SS H\#3.5 T-CH
Row 10: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 18 YO SS BLO H\#6.5

Repeat this until Row 13
With the next row we'll start decreasing by leaving every second chain, going up, undone

Row 14: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO
H\#3.5, 16 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, T-CH
Row 15: 16 YO SS BLO using H\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH

Repeat this pattern until Row 21, decreasing every second row by 2 and at the last Row you should have total of 15 stitches


## Front right panel

CH 23 H\#6.5
Row 1: 18 YO SS using H\#6, 4 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 2: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 18 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 20 YO SS BLO using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 4: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 20 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work

We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 9, 30 stitches total

Row 9: 26 YO SS BLO using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 10: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 26 YO SS BLO H\#6.5,

Repeat this until Row 14


## Front Left panel

CH 31
Row 1: 26 YO SS using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 2: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 26 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 28 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH
Repeat this until Row 5
Now well start decreasing 2 every other row by leaving 2 chains undone

Row 6: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 24 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 T-CH
Row 7: 24 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5 T-CH

Repeat pattern until Row 13, 22 stitches in total Leave a long tail so you can SS to the back panel

## CH 23 H\#6.5

Row 1: 18 YO SS using H\#6, 4 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 2: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 18 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 20 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 4: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 20 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work

We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 9, 30 stitches total

Row 9: 26 YO SS BLO using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5
T-CH
Row 10: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 26 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 T-CH

Repeat this until Row 15


Now we'll do the part for the neck
Row 16: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 24 YO SS BLO H\# 6.5 T-CH
Row 17: 24 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5 T-CH
Row 18: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 22 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work
Row 19: 24 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5 T-CH
Row 20: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 24 YO SS BLO
H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work
Row 21: 26 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 4 YO SS BLO H\# 3.5 T-CH
Row 22: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 26 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 T-CH

Repeat alternating these 2 rows until Row 27
Start decreasing leaving 2 chains undone every second row, until Row 35 where you'll have 22 stitches in total


## Collar

CH 4 H\#5

## Row 1: 3 YO SS,

T-CH
Row 2: 3 YO SS BLO
T-CH
Row3: 3 YO SS BLO,
$\mathrm{T}-\mathrm{CH}$
Repeat this alternating 2 nd and 3rd row
until Row 74

$$
\mathrm{T}-\mathrm{CH}
$$

Crochet across in every available loop 74 YO SS
Then you'll connect collar to the body SS only back loop once everything else is connected


## Pocket

CH 6 H\#5
Row 1: 5 YO SS
T-CH
Row 2: 5 YO SS BLO
T-CH
Row 3: 5 YO SS BLO

SS everything together

## Sleeves

CH 21 H\#6.5
Row 1: 15 YO SS using H\#6.5, 5 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 2: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 15 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 17 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 5 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 4: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 17 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, CH 3 turn your work
We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 9, 28 stitches total

Row 9: 23 YO SS BLO using H\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH
Row 10: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 23 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, T-CH

## Repeat until Row 13

With the next row we'll start decreasing by leaving every second chain, going up, undone
Row 14: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 23 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, T-CH
Row 15: 23 YO SS using H\#6.5, 5 YO SS H\#3.5, T-CH

Repeat this pattern until row 21, decreasing every second row by 2 and at the last Row you should have total of 20 stitches Take your hook out and put it in the first loop of the foundation chain on the opposite side and start SS the sleeve together Cut the yarn leaving approx 40 cm so you can connect the sleeve to the body

Row 1: 24 YO SS using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Row 2: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 24 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Row 4: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 9, $\mathbf{3 6}$ stitches total
Row 9: 31 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5
CH 1 turn your work
Row 10: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 31 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 1, turn your work

CH 37 H\#6.5
Row 1: 36 YO SS using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Row 2: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 36 YO SS BLO H\#6
CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 38 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Repeat this pattern alternating between rows 2 and 3 until Row 7
Now well start decreasing by 2 every other row by leaving every second row 2 chains undone
Row 8: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 34 YO SS BLO H\#6
CH 1 turn your work
Row 9: 34 YO SS BLO H\#6, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5
CH 1 turn your work

Repeat pattern until Row 15, 20 stitches in total

## CH 29 H\#6.5

Row 1: 24 YO SS using H\#6.5, 4 YO SS H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Row 2: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 24 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 30 YO SS BLO\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, CH 1 turn your work
Row 4: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
We'll repeat this pattern,
increasing by 2 every other row until Row 9, $\mathbf{3 6}$ stitches total
Row 9: 31 YO SS BLO\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3. 5
CH 1 turn your work
Row 10: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 31 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 1, turn your work

## Repeat this until you have total of $\mathbf{1 7}$ Rows

Row 18: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 1 turn your work
Row 19: 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS H\#3.5
CH 1 turn your work
Row 20: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 28 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 3 turn your work
Row 21: 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS H\#3.5
CH 1 turn your work
Row 22: 4 YO SS BLO \#3.5, 30 YO SS BLO \#6.5 CH 3 turn your work

Row 23: 32 YO SS BLO \#6.5 4 YO SS BLO \#3.5 CH 1 turn your work
Row 24: 4 YO SS BLO \#3.5, 32 YO SS BLO \#6.5
Repeat this until Row 31

Now well start decreasing by 2 every other row leaving 2 last chains undone

Row 32: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 1 turn your work
Row 33: 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5
CH 1 turn your work
Row 34: 4 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 28 YO SS BLO H\#6.5 CH 1 turn your work

Repeat pattern until Row 39, 28 stitches in total

Cut the yarn leaving approx 1 m to connect back to the front panel

## Collar

CH 4 H\#5
Row 1: 3 YO SS, T-CH
Row 2: 3 YO SS BLO, T-CH
Row 3: 3 YO SS BLO, T-CH

## Repeat this until Row 86 <br> CH 1 turn your work

Crochet across in every available loop $\mathbf{8 6}$ YO SS

Connect collar when you have all the other parts connected,
slip stitching it through the back loops only

## Pocket

CH 6 H\#5

## Row 1: 5 YO SS

T-CH
Row 2: 5 YO SS BLO
T-CH

Repeat this until you have total of $\mathbf{7}$ rows

Connect everything with a SS

## 6-12 months

## Sleeves

## CH 26 H\#6.5

Row 1: 20 YO SS using H\#6.5, 5 YO SS H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Row 2: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 20 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
Row 3: 22 YO SS BLO\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5,
CH 1 turn your work
Row 4: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 22 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 11, $\mathbf{3 5}$ stitches total

Row 11: 30 YO SS BLO\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLOH\#3.5, T-CH
Row 12: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 30 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, T-CH Repeat this until Row 15

With the next row we'll start decreasing by leaving every second chain, going up, undone
Row 16: 3 SS BLO H\#3.5, 2 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 28 YO SS BLO H\#6.5, T-CH
Row 17: 28 YO SS BLO\#6.5, 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, T-CH

Repeat this pattern until row 25, decreasing every second row by 2 and at the last Row you should have total of 25 stitches Ch 1 turn
Take your hook out and put it in the first loop of the foundation chain on the opposite side and start SS the sleeve together
Cut the yarn leaving approx 40 cm so you can connect the sleeve to the body

The same pattern goes for the other sleeve in different colour

CH 1 turn your work
Row 4: 5 YO SS BLO H\#3.5, 29 YO SS BLO H\#6.5
CH 3 turn your work
We'll repeat this pattern, increasing by 2 every other row until Row 11, 42 stitches total

Crochet across in every available loop 99 YO SS

Connect colar when you have all the other parts connected, slip stitchig it through the back loops only

Cut the yarn leaving approx 40 cm so you can connect the sleeve to the body
