

Sierra Beanie

Sizes: 0-3 months, 3-6 months, 6-12 months 12-18 months, Todler, Child, Adult

Beginner friendly pattern!


This pattern is a very simple one, super easy and quick to make, choose any colour you want or even combine colours and you'll have yourself a cute beanie for a last minute gift of for yourself. You can add a pompon or leave it without and it will be just as cute.

Stitches that you need to know:

slip stitch yarn over slip stitch decrease

The abbreviations that I'll use throughout the pattern are:

CH - chain
SS - slip stitch
YO - yarn over
BLO - back loop only
DEC - decrease



Scissors

Materials you'll be using:

- bulky weight yarn A 6.5 mm crochet needle Tapestry needle
- Pompom (optional)
- Stitch marker(optional)
- The amount of yarn you'll use depends on the size of the hat

Newborn (o-3 months old)

40 grams of yarn


We're gonna start this hat by making a brim first

Make a slip knot and chain 4




Row 1: in the second chain from the hook make YO SS and do the same with the remaining two stitches.

CH 1, turn your work



Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next two stitches and in the third, last stitch YO SS through both loops

CH 1, turn your work



Row 3: YO SS BLO in all three stitches

CH 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 36 TOWS

Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 3 stitches

CH 1, turn your work





Row I: YO SS in the first loop (as shown in the photo), continue doing this for the next 36 stitches.

To connect SS I

CH I, turn your work








This is what you should have after you've finished the first row. Row 2: YO SS BLO 36 stitches, SS

CH 1, turn your work

Repeat this until you get to the total of 5 rows

Make sure you are counting the stitches so you don't miss any, you can always place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the row to help you keep track





Now we'll start decreasing

Row 6: YO SS BLO next 3 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 7: YO SS BLO 29 stitches total

Row 8: 2 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 9: YO SS BLO 22 stitches

Row 10: I YO SS BLO, I DEC until the end of the row

Row 11: YO SS BLO 14 stitches total

Row 12: all DEC, 7 stitches total





Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 15 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can sew in the end and secure the top of the hat.





3 - 6 months old 55 grams of yarn

Make a slip knot and chain 5

Row: 1 in the second chain from the hook make YO SS and do the same with the remaining 3 stitches. CH 1, turn your work

Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next 3 stitches and in the third, last stitch HDCSS through both loops CH 1, turn your work

> Row 3: YO SS BLO in all 4 stitches CH 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 40 rows

Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 4 stitches CH 1, turn your work (wrong side facing you)

Row I: YO SS in the first loop, continue doing this for the next 40 stitches. To connect SS 1 CH 1, turn your work

> Row 2: YO SS BLO 40 stitches, SS CH 1, turn your work Repeat this until you get to the total of 5 rows

> > Now we'll start decreasing

Row 6: YO SS BLO next 4 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 7: YO SS BLO 34 stitches

Row 8: 3 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 9: YO SS BLO 28 stitches

Repeat this with decreasing every second row until you are left with decreasing stitches only, 13 rows total -°è+Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 15 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can saw in the end and secure the top of the hat

6 - 12 months 65 grams of yarn

We're gonna start this hat by making a brim first Make a slip knot and chain 5

Row: 1 in the second chain from the hook do YO SS and do the same with the remaining 3 stitches. Chain 1, turn your work

Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next 3 stitches and in the third, last stitch YO SS through both loops Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 3: YO SS BLO in all 4 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 44 rows

Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 4 stitches

Chain 1, turn your work

Row 1: YO SS in the first loop, continue doing this for the next 44 stitches. To connect slip stitch 1 Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 2: YO SS BLO 44 stitches, SS Chain 1, turn your work

Repeat this until you get to the total of 7 rows

Now we'll start decreasing

Row 8: YO SS BLO next 3 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 9: YO SS BLO 35 stitches total

Row 10: 2 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 11: YO SS BLO 27 stitches total Repeat this with decreasing every second row until you are left with decreasing stitches only, 14 rows in total

Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 15 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can saw in the end and secure the top of the hat

12-18 months 70 grams of yarn

We're gonna start this hat by making a brim first

Make a slip knot and chain 5

Row: 1 in the second chain from the hook do YO SS and do the same with the remaining 3 stitches. CH 1, turn your work

Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next two stitches and in the last stitch YO SS through both loops CH 1, turn your work

> Row 3: YO SS BLO in all 5 stitches CH 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 46 rows

Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 5 stitches CH 1, turn your work

Row 1: YO SS in the first loop, continue doing this for the next 46 stitches. To connect slip stitch 1 CH 1, turn your work

> Row 2: YO SS BLO 46 stitches, SS CH 1, turn your work

Repeat this until you get to the total of 7 rows

Now we'll start decreasing

Row 8: YO SS BLO next 4 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 9: YO SS BLO 39 stitches total

Row 10: 3 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 11: YO SS BLO 31 stitches total

Repeat this with decreasing every second row until you are left with decreasing stitches only, 15 rows total Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 15 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can saw in the end and secure the top of the hat

Toddler 75 grams of yarn

We're gonna start this hat by making a brim first Make a slip knot and chain 5

Row: 1 in the second chain from the hook do YO SS and do the same with the remaining 3 stitches. Chain 1, turn your work

Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next two stitches and in the last stitch YO SS through both loops Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 3: YO SS BLO in all 5 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 48 rows

Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 5 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Row I: YO SS in the first loop, continue doing this for the next 48 stitches. To connect SS 1 Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 2: YO SS BLO 48 stitches, SS Chain 1, turn your work

Repeat this until you get to the total of 7 rows

Now we'll start decreasing

Row 8: YO SS BLO next 4 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 9: YO SS BLO 40 stitches total

Row 10: 3 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 11: YO SS BLO 32 stitches total

Repeat this with decreasing every second row until you are left with decreasing stitches only

Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 10 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can saw in the end and secure the top of the hat

85 grams of yarn

We're gonna start this hat by making a brim first Make a slip knot and chain 6

Row: 1 in the second chain from the hook do YO SS and do the same with the remaining 4 stitches. Chain 1, turn your work

Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next two stitches and in the 5th, last stitch YO SS through both loops Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 3: YO SS BLO in all 5 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 50 rows

Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 5 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Row I: YO SS in the first loop, continue doing this for the next 50 stitches. To connect slip stitch 1 Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 2: YO SS BLO 50 stitches, SS Chain 1, turn your work Repeat this until you get to the total of 7 rows

> > Now we'll start decreasing

Row 8: YO SS BLO next 5 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 9: YO SS BLO 43 stitches in total

Row 10: 4 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 11: YO SS BLO 36 stitches in total Repeat this with decreasing every second row until you get to the row 16

Row 17 do the decreasing stitches only, 6 stitches in total + 1 YO SS

Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 10 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can saw in the end and secure the top of the hat

Adult 100 grams of yarn

We're gonna start this hat by making a brim first Make a slip knot and chain 7

Row: 1 in the second chain from the hook do YO SS and do the same with the remaining 5 stitches. Chain 1, turn your work

Row 2: YO SS BLO in the next two stitches and in the last stitch YO SS through both loops (as shown on the photo) Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 3: YO SS BLO in all 6 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Keep repeating this pattern until you get to the total of 54 rows Once you finish the rows you're going to connect them with the SS in all 6 stitches Chain 1, turn your work

Row 1: YO SS in the first loop (as shown in the photo), continue doing this for the next 54 stitches. To connect SS 1 Chain 1, turn your work

> Row 2: YO SS BLO 54 stitches, SS Chain 1, turn your work Repeat this until you get to the total of 7 rows

> > Now we'll start decreasing

Row 8: YO SS BLO next 5 stitches, DEC 1, repeat this pattern until you finish the row.

Row 9: YO SS BLO 47 stitches total

Row 10: 4 stitches YO SS BLO, DEC 1, until you finish the row

Row 11: YO SS BLO 39 stitches total

Repeat this with decreasing every second row until you are left with decreasing stitches only, 17 rows total Once you're done, cut the yarn leaving 10 cm if you're going to attach a pompom, if not cut just enough so you can saw in the end and secure the top of the hat



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
