SUNBURST BAG









Maierials you'll be using

Cotton yarn: fine #2 40 gr

4 mm crochet hook

scissors

stitch markers (optional)

Stitches you'll be using for this project:

*I'll be using US stitch terminology

Chain

Slip stitch

Yarn over slip stitch

Half double crochet (UK double crochet)

Double croche (UK treble crochet)

Treble crochet (UK double treble)

Puff stitch

Cluster stitch

Abbreviations we'll be using:

CH - chain

SS - slip stitch

YOSS - yarn over slip stitch

HDC - half double crochet

DC - double crochet

TC - treble crochet

BLO -back loop only

TCH - turning chain



Front and Back

Make 2 Sunburst Granny Squares

*pattern

R 1 - CH3, 15DC, SS to connect (16 stitches total counting the CH3)

SS to connect

R 2 - 16 puff stitches, SS to connect

R 3 - 16 cluster stitches, SS to connect

R 4 -2 HDC, 3 DC, 3TC CH2 3TC (in the same stitch), 3DC, 3HDC, 3DC, 3TC CH2 3TC, 3DC, 3HDC, 3TC CH2 3TC, 3DC, 3HDC, 3TC CH2 3TC, 3DC, 3HDC, 3TC CH2 3TC, 3 DC, 1HDC

*I have a step by step video tutorial for Sunburst granny square on my YT channel

Sides and Shoulder strap CH 151

Row 1 - SS 150 in the back loops of the chain, TCH

Row 2: YOSS 150 BLO, TCH

Row 3: SS BLO 150, TCH

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you have total of 7 rows

To connect you'll start from the corner of the granny square, and into the second chain, of the CH 2 we did in the corner.

Start SS across the whole side of the square, connecting one granny square to one side of the long strap you did, you should have 16 stitches total

Then let go of the strap and SS across top side of the square, 17 SS Get your strap again, make sure it's not twisted, then skip 34 stitches (that's how many stitches you have on two side of the square), counting from the bottom of the strap, then start SS the granny square to the strap again, all the way to the next corner SS the corner, connecting two straps together at the bottom, you should have 7 SS Get the second granny square and conncet it in the same way Weave in the two ends and you are all done.
